# CANADIAN VIEWS ON GENOCIDE PREVENTION ON THE EVE OF THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LIBERATION OF AUSCHWITZ

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### INTRODUCTION

In historic and contemporary debate about genocide prevention there is much discussion about what can be done to prevent such atrocities from being committed. Some contend that to insist on non engagement when there is knowledge about genocide can itself be seen as a form of silent complicity. The issue of whether to take action where we know a genocide is taking place raises questions about our moral responsibility as a society. The poll's reveal that nearly one-third of Canadians disagree with sending Canadian troops to where a genocide is occurring and another ten percent prefer not to answer raises key questions about how we see our role in helping those peoples that are dangerously vulnerable.



#### **METHODOLOGY**

 The survey was commissioned by the Association for Canadian Studies and conducted by the firm Leger Marketing with a sample of 2295 Canadians nationally via web panel during the week of November 11th, 2019. It has a probabilistic margin of error of 2.5 percent 19 times out of 20.

### UNDERLYING FACTORS

- What underlies the views of the nearly one in three Canadians that disagree with sending Canadian troops to a place where genocide is occurring.
- The survey reveals that socio-demographic factors (age, gender, education and income) do not play a decisive role in shaping opinion. Rather it is identity based views that appear to drive opposition to sending troops to where a genocide is occurring. Such opposition is therefore connected to attitudes immigrants and religious minorities where those holding more negative views of such groups and/or distrusting them are less inclined to support intervention where genocide is taking place.
