The State of Canadian Culture and the perceived need to protect it

Introduction

What is Canadian culture? Is there a singular culture or is it better to speak about cultures when thinking about what it means to be Canadian? How important is it to protect Canadian content when it comes to music, film, art. etc? In response to these and other questions, the Association for Canadian Studies commissioned the firm Leger to survey Canadians on their arts and cultural consumption habits and look specifically at Canadians preferred genre of art, music and film.

The findings arise from a Leger survey for the ACS that was conducted between November 3 to November 5, 2022 via web panel with 1704 Canadians. No margin of error can be associated with a non-probability sample (Web panel in this case). However for comparative purposes, a probability sample of 1764 respondents would have a margin of error of ±2.5%, 19 times out of 20
