The Canadian Institute for Identities and Migration, a division of the Association for Canadian Studies (ACS) – is excited to re-launch their cornerstone publication *Indexing Integration: A Review of National and International Models*. Jack Jedwab, the president of ACS, will present this publication highlighting existing immigrant integration indices, and explain how this foundational report has driven the creation of the Canadian Index for Measuring Integration (CIMI).

The CIMI is a tool that evaluates the state of immigrant integration across Canada. Using extensive datasets, the CIMI assesses changes and trends in immigrant integration over time and across demographics based on selected key dimensions such as economics, health, social, and civic and democratic participation. The CIMI enhances Policy-Makers and Service Providing Organizations' (SPOs) ability to design policies and programs by providing evidence-based trend analysis in several areas germane to immigrant integration within the city.
